Basic Information for Admission

1. Course Detail:

- 1.1 I.T.I (2 years duration), in Fitter & Electrician trade, recognised by NCVT, Govt. of India & DIT, Govt. of West Bengal.
- 1.2 Exam Board - Govt. of West Bengal.

2. Eligibility for Admission:

Madhyamik / H.S. / Graduate / Polytechnic / B. Tech. There is no age bar.

3. Course Fee:

- 3.1 Admission Fee: Rs.12,000/- (to be paid at the time of admission)
- 3.2 Exam Fee: Rs.2,000/- (to be paid before 1st year & 2nd year examination)
- 3.3 Registration Fee: Rs.1,000/- (to be paid before 10th August 2020)
- 3.4 Monthly Instalment: Rs.2,000/- for 9 months starting from November 2020 & Rs. 2500/- for 12 months starting from August 2021 (to be paid by 7th in each month) (payment may be made by cash/cheque/bank deposit)

4. Total Course Fee for 2 years:

Rs.63,000/- (Sixty Three Thousands only).

5. Institute support at the time of registration (free of cost)

2 sets uniform, drawing instruments, college bag & document file.

6. Library Facility:

11. Admission Procedure:

- 11.1 Filling up of Admission Form (to be obtained from the office).
- 11.2 Photocopy of Admit Card, Marksheet & Certificate of all examination passed.
- 11.3 Photocopy of Aadhar Card.
- 11.4 Photocopy of SC/ST/OBC/Minority Certificate.
- 11.5 4 nos. Passport Size Photograph (colour or black & white)

12. Selection for Admission:

First come first serve basis and if availability of seats.

13. Special Facility:

- 13.1 Rail Concession to & fro from your residence to Kalyani.
- 13.2 Availability of Bank Loan.
- 13.3 Govt. Scholarship facilities for SC/ST/OBC/Minority – as per rule of the govt.
- 13.4 Laminated photo identity card.

14. Condition of Studies:

- 14.1 Monthly instalment must has to be paid even the classes are not possible to be organised. Attendance at least 60% class in a month otherwise dis-collegiate fees to be imposed.
- 14.2 Every student must wear uniform, shoe & carry institutional bag for attending classes.
- 14.3 Consumption of alcohol/cigarette/pan/jarda/gutkha is strictly prohibited in the institutional campus and in the travel college bus service.
- 14.3 Ragging or any other indiscipline attitude will not be tolerated and punishable offence.
- 14.4 Forming of students' union will not be allowed.
- 14.5 Students must receive Money Receipt against any payment to the institute.
- 14.6 The candidate must accept the exam procedure as per instruction of the govt. of India.

15. Higher Study:

After passing of ITI course, the students are eligible for getting admission direct to the 2nd year course in the polytechnic college for pursuing diploma engineering course.

16. Special Instruction:

The candidates once admitted and getting registration, may please noted that they will not be able for taking admission in any other ITI. If otherwise, the application of the candidate will be discharged and the money deposited for admission and monthly fees and others will not be refunded at any cost.

17. Exam Procedure:

The practical examination is held at the institute. The institutional examiner will organise the examination. The drawing examination is held nearby ITI but the answer script is evaluated by our teacher. All the theory examination is held nearby ITI through OMR sheet.
